

## CERTIFICATE OF COMPETENCY AS INSHORE COXSWAIN

The Northern Territory Marine Act requires that persons in charge of vessels in NT waters meet prescribed certification requirements.

### The Certificate

The Inshore Coxswain certificate allows the holder to be the master of vessels of less than 8 metres in waters within a limit of 5 nautical miles seaward of the low water mark; to take charge of the propulsion machinery of vessels less than 8 metres in length with outboard propulsion machinery of less than 250kw total power of all outboard motors fitted.

Documented evidence of at least 12 month sea service on any vessel must be presented and approved by Marine Safety Branch in order to be eligible for assessment. **(Copy of letter from Marine Safety Branch stating eligibility must be given to SMIT administration when enrolling)** Please contact the NT Marine Safety Branch – 2<sup>nd</sup> floor, Energy House, 18 Cavenagh St., Darwin NT, phone 08 89247100, fax 08 89247009.

### The Program

This Inshore Coxswain program runs for 5 days full-time, both in theoretical and practical elements.

This qualification is part completion of Certificate II in Transport & Distribution (Coastal Maritime Operations – Coxswain)

Pre-requisite courses need to be completed before issue of Certificate of competency as Inshore Coxswain from Marine Safety Branch. These include:

**NOTE** All certificates (ESS - first aid, personal survival technique, fire fighting & Radio) can be collected approximately 2 ~ 3 weeks after completion of programs & full payment of fees is received.

TDMMC907C Manoeuvre a domestic vessel within limits of responsibility of a Coxswain

TDMMH1207B Plan & navigate a short voyage within inshore limits

TDMMR2307B Operate & maintain batteries, starter motors & power distribution systems
