Personal Survival Techniques

The Marine Orders requires that persons in charge of vessels meet prescribed certification requirements. Survival at Sea is a pre-requisite required for Personal Safety Techniques certificate issue.

The Certificate

The Personal Survival techniques Certificate is a pre-requisite qualification required by the Australian Maritime Safety Authority for obtaining an STCW 95 Endorsement for holders of state issued certificates of competency.

The Course

Chapter VI of the STCW 95 code states in part that 'before being assigned to shipboard duties all persons employed on a seagoing ship shall receive approved familiarisation training in personal survival techniques. This course covers the minimum requirements outlined in Section A-VI/1-4 to fulfil this familiarisation training.

Assessment

On achieving the units of Competencies the following will be demonstrated:

1. Prepare contingency plans for emergency response
2. Develop plans for damage control following a shipboard emergency
3. Develop plans for fire protection, detection and extinction
4. Develop procedures for the use of various life-saving appliances
5. Coordinate the implementation of emergency response plans
6. Implement safety before entering tanks or confined spaces

The assessment consists of multiple choice answers and written short answer responses.

<i>TDMMF5407A</i>	<i>Observe safety and emergency procedures on a coastal vessel</i>
